#### PROPOSAL COMPONENTS

### STATEMENT OF NEED

Proposed cuts in the Federal Budget could eliminate the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program. Therefore, there is a need to promote student advocacy to protect and bolster the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program (PLSF). For more information click <a href="here">here</a>.

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Pi Alpha Alpha (PAA) chapters will develop grant proposals describing how chapters will develop a grassroots advocacy plan using students and alumni to outreach to and educate their members of Congress about the need to protect PLSF. Ideas include one or a combination of the following: organizing letter writing or phone calling campaigns; lobbying members of Congress in Washington and/or in their local districts, or creating and posting videos to various social media channels. #### **BUDGET**

There will be 2 (two) – \$500 grant proposals awarded by the national PAA committee. The proposal must include an itemized budget and justification.

### ORGANIZATION INFORMATION

Each proposal must indicate the name of the PAA advisor and contact information.

#### CONCLUSION

Applicant must provide a statement which includes project goals and expectations.

# **CRITERIA**

NASPAA member school in good standing and associated local PAA chapter that has inducted students within the last 12 months.

Awards will be based on:

- Adherence to proposal requirements
- Presenting a timeline/calendar of activities
- Staffing of students and alumni as opposed to faculty and staff
- Linking to other organizations advocating for PSLF

Note: The grants shall not be used for induction or commencement ceremonies.

Proposal submitted by the deadline of 11:59pm on Friday, June 2, 2017 will be considered. Submission by mail or electronic/portal.

### **SCORING OF PROPOSAL**

The committee can decide how to score the proposal-points per segment.
