Directions to UMBC

From the north: from Interstate 95, take Exit 47B, Catonsville (Route 166), and follow signs to UMBC. Turn right on Hilltop Circle. At the second stop sign turn left onto Commons Drive and left into the Commons Parking Lot.

From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695), take Exit 12C (Wilkins Avenue, west). Turn left on Wilkins Avenue to traffic circle. Follow signs to UMBC. Bear right at Hilltop Road and right at Hilltop Circle (traffic light). At the second stop sign turn left onto Commons Drive and left into the Commons Parking Lot.

From the south: take Interstate 95 to Exit 47B, Catonsville (Route 166); follow signs to UMBC. Turn right on Hilltop Circle. At the second stop sign turn left onto Commons Drive and left into the Commons Parking Lot.

From BWI Westin Hotel: The BWI Westin Hotel is 10 minutes from the UMBC campus. You can obtain driving directions to UMBC from the hotel.

Parking

Except for meters, parking in campus lots or roadways requires a permit Monday through Friday (until 3:30 p.m.). Cars without permits parked in campus lots, or on roadways, will be ticketed by the campus police.

Friday: Forum attendees should park in metered spaces in the lot on Commons Drive on Friday. Attendees planning to arrive by car can e-mail Anne Roland (anne@umbc.edu) to obtain a complimentary parking permit in advance. Parking is also available in metered garages located at Administration Drive, and Walker Avenue. Meters are enforced Monday through Friday for hours posted. Meter fees are \$.25 for each 15 minutes, quarters only, maximum time of 5 hours.

Saturday: The University does not require permits or enforce meters on Saturday.
