

1. Shuttle / Transfer services

-- Transvip – One of the most widely used and reliable services, offering both shared vans and private transfers. (<https://www.transvip.cl/>)

-- WeTransport – Official airport provider with 24/7 shared and private options.

2. Bus services (very common and cost-effective)

-- Centropuerto – Blue buses operating every 10–15 minutes, connecting the airport with key Metro stations such as Pajaritos and República. (<https://centropuerto.cl/>)

-- TurBus Aeropuerto – Green buses running every 15–20 minutes to major terminals like Pajaritos and Alameda. (<https://www.turbus.cl/>)

These buses operate daily and are a safe and widely used option; many travelers take them to a Metro station and then continue to their final destination.

3. Additional options

-- Official airport taxis and pre-booked transfers available at authorized counters inside the airport.

In general, shuttle services are more convenient for direct hotel drop-off, while buses are a very good low-cost alternative.
