A program is monitored on a specific standard(s) when the Commission deems that the program is in overall conformance, yet needs improvement in a specific conformance area, or the Commission wishes to follow the implementation of a new practice. The program is expected to respond to monitoring provisions each year in its Annual Report, until the program is notified that those provisions have been eliminated by COPRA.

\* As the COVID-19 pandemic unfolded, it became clear that site visits occurring in mid-to-late March and early April would be directly impacted by the shift to distance learning, restrictions on travel, extended spring breaks, and campus closures. As a result, COPRA offered programs the option to postpone the site visit to be scheduled in the 2020-2021 review year. Programs postponing the site visit maintain their current accreditation status, will incur no additional fees, nor will their maximum accreditation term be impacted.
